TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The promoter is Tauranga Crossing, located at 2 Taurikura Drive, Tauriko 3110, Tauranga.
2. The Promotional Period commences Thursday 14 October 2021 at 12.00am.
3. To enter the Promotion, the entrant must nominate a registered club or team by filling in the entire entry form found at: <https://www.taurangacrossing.co.nz/news/local-legends/>. Applications must include a statement of less than 500 words explaining the reason for the application and why it deserves a grant. Applications can be supported by submitting photos or a video. Instructions on uploading these with the application are available and form part of the entry form.
4. Only registered organisation, group, club, or team that reside in the Bay of Plenty, New Zealand are eligible to be nominated.
5. One nomination per person is permitted. The entrant must be authorised by their club or team to make the application on its behalf.
6. False, misleading, or inappropriate entries will be disqualified.
7. There is a Local Legends \$5,000 Grant awarded quarterly.
8. The winner of the grant is the registered organisation, group, club, or team that is nominated.
9. A panel of appointed judges will review all applications that are eligible for consideration for a grant. The judges will assess the merits of each entry and select three finalists.
10. A community online voting process will commence for the duration of one month:
 - a. Vote via Tauranga Crossing website.
 - b. Three finalists will be showcases with imagery and story on webpage.
 - c. One vote per email per day.
 - d. No fake emails are permitted. They will be deducted from the total number of votes.
 - e. By voting for a finalist, voters agree to join the Tauranga Crossing VIP Club database.
11. The Promoter reserves the right to offer the grant to the next community group with the highest votes if the promoter is unable to contact a winner after four attempts by 5.00pm the following day using the contact details provided by the entrant.
12. In the event a successful entry's situation has changed, or in the opinion of the Promoter the reasons for the grant are no longer necessary in any way, the Promoter reserves the right to reassess grant or cancel the grant.
13. The promoter will not be liable for any loss, damages or injury which is suffered or sustained arising out of connection with the promotion and will not replace them.

14. Entrants acknowledge that the promoter reserves the right, at its discretion, to use the entrant's names and photographs for publicity purposes.
